

ANM Nursing:

ANM Nursing is a 1 year & 2 year diploma course. It primarily deals with the health care sector. The course provides knowledge about setting up operation theatre, taking care of various equipment, maintaining records, and also administering timely medication to patients.

The required eligibility criteria for pursuing ANM courses is that candidates have to score a minimum of 45% aggregate marks in their 10+2 exams. Also, their age must not cross the 18-year mark. [ANM Nursing Syllabus](#) focuses on providing basic nursing and medical skills to provide medical assistance to the doctor or more experienced nurses.



What are ANM Nursing Courses?

ANM or Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery is primarily a diploma course, focusing on the study of the health of mankind. Besides, while learning this course, candidates are also taught regarding the Operation Theatre, its functioning, various types of equipment, and how to handle them. The significant motive of the ANM course is to train the candidates in functioning as basic health workers in society and give treatment to children, women, and aged people

Generally, Child Health Nursing, Health Promotion, Midwifery, Health Care Management, Primary and Community Health Nursing, are the subjects of ANM. An aspirant desiring to pursue this course needs to have patience, should be alert, be physically fit, and have responsibility. ANM has good career scope as well, and has multiple job opportunities, in various areas, including NGOs, Government Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Private Hospitals, etc.

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| Nursing Tutor | A professional nursing tutor is the one who provides various additional nursing instructions assisting the nursing students to study it. A nursing tutor focuses more on a student facing trouble in a particular area, and helps them to make strategies on decent study planning and execute it well, eventually helping them to improve. | 15 |
| HealthCare Nurse | A health care nurse provides care to the ill or injured patients, tries to handle their physical needs, and also helps in treating health conditions. They are also responsible for observing and monitoring the patients to analyse their problems. | Certified Nursing Assistant | A certified nursing assistant provides direct health care needs to the patients, which are regulated often under the nurse's supervision. They are also the assistants for a patient's care. | 2.5 |

They are responsible for giving care to the patients who are suffering from life-threatening conditions or illnesses.
